Büchmann Seminare KG Preetz

In 2006, at the age of 52, Ute Büchmann discovers a gap: According to her research, there are still no offers for mental senior citizen support. She founds "enior care assistant", which becomes the company Büchmann Seminare KG in 2007 and qualifies experienced senior citizens as senior assistant assistants.

Senior Assistants, as self-employed service providers, accompany older people with or without care in the home environment and ensure their social participation in social life. Initially organized regionally In Preetz in Schleswig-Holstein, the concept is known as the Plön model. Further seminar locations in Hamburg, Berlin, Leverkusen, Nuremberg and Kempen in North Rhine-Westphalia are added. In addition to the support for seniors, the model also offers people after the family phase, a new entry into professional life.




